67H 27 THE 10 COMMANDMENTS

In these last days we live in a time in which there is little love and violence is growing. **Matthew 24:12** "And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold." From the beginning, the evil of killing has been a problem, imagine how much more today. **Genesis 6:11** "The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence." Many think they are innocent, but in reality they are committing this sin. **Exodus 20:13** "Thou shalt not kill."

The sin of murder (killing) begins in the mind, every man having hatred for his brother, has this iniquity. 1st John 3:15 "Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him." The saying, "I am a good person, I have never killed anyone" is invalid when we truly examine ourselves. This is said by those who do not keep the commandments of God, their works show it.
