



KNOWING THE JUDGMENT OF GOD

Most people think of the Bible as a book of fantasies and irrelevant in these modern times. In the beginning chapters you read of a serpent tricking Eve and convincing her to disobey God (sin) by saying; **Genesis 3:4** “*And the serpent said unto the woman, YE SHALL NOT SURELY DIE:” In the end of the Bible you read of this same serpent deceiving; **Revelations 12:9** “*And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world:...*” But what if we have been deceived? What if it is not fantasy? What if the things you do affect how you are judged in this current life and in eternity? Unfortunately for our people they have been deceived into believing the doctrine of the serpent, causing them to be unaware of the evidence that shows the scriptures to be true. If they go to church it is only to be told again **YE SHALL NOT SURELY DIE.** **2nd Corinthians 5:11** “*Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.*”*

Those who are descendants of the slaves (Blacks, Hispanics, Native Americans) will never deny the horrible history that happened to their ancestors. Making it *manifest in their consciences* of how the things written in the scriptures are true because slavery was predicted (prophesied) as punishment for our sins. **Deuteronomy 28:45** “*Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which he commanded thee:*” There's no question that the scriptures are essential to our everyday life when the *curses* are read. A person would no longer doubt the Bible since these curses affect us even today. **Deuteronomy 28:46** “*And they [the curses] shall be upon thee for a sign and for a wonder, and upon thy seed for ever.*” Yet the good news (gospel) is that those children of slaves are identified by the curses/prophesy as the true children of Israel. To whom the opportunity of forgiveness, promises of eternal life, the kingdom, has been promised to. See, **Luke 4:16-19**, **Romans 9:3-5**, and **John 4:22**. But if we do not take heed to the gospel as it was said by Moses these curses will be upon you until “*thou be destroyed*”. **2nd Thessalonians 1:8** “*In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:” **Verse 9:** “*Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;”**

Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord and seeing that many things that are happening today are signs of the times, we attempt to persuade our people who are ignorant of their heritage as an Israelite. **Romans 1:32** “*Who knowing the judgment of God,...*” Most people do not know that they are going to be judged according to the judgments written in the law. **Romans 2:12** “*For as many as have sinned without [knowing the] law shall also perish without law [To perish means to be put to death. Ignorance is not bliss since it cannot be used as an excuse in judgment day. They will still be destroyed at the second coming of Christ.] : and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law:”* **Revelations 20:12** “*And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.*” This one verse reveals a lot about how we will be judged. To begin it shows that the Heavenly Father will judge all whether your status was “*small*” or “*great*” he has no respect of persons. A lot of our people have the saying that “*only God can judge me*”, but here we see that you will be judged by the same books that are collectively called the Bible. Why not take warning from those that God sent to correct you of your sins? At the end of it all we all are going to be judged according to our **works**. Here it is the churches tell you that you do not need works, but the scriptures show different. The book of life is where the names of those who will receive the kingdom are written. When people read the word death in the law of Moses they shrug it off as nothing since they say “*we all die*”. But if we continue to read in Revelations our view would greatly change. **Revelations 20:14** “*And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.”* **Verse 15:** “*And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.*” The death that Moses was referring to is “*the second death*” where the punishment is being “*cast into the lake of fire.*” For example, **Matthew 15:4** “*...and, He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death.*” From that example we could clearly see that Christ taught the commandments, and judgments! To *die the death* is to die a second death.

Hebrews 10:26 “*For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,”* **Verse 27:** “*But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.*” Oh how often do we meet brothers and sisters that believe that they will have mercy if they continue to break the commandments willfully? The commandments have no effect on them since they have been taught by the serpent that they will not be judged for their sin. **Hebrews 10:28** “*He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:”* Through the laws we learn the mercy that the Heavenly Father gives. If a person committed a sin worthy of death they didn't receive mercy but were punished with death once it was confirmed by witnesses. **Deuteronomy 21:22** “*And if a man have committed a sin worthy of death,...*” An example of a sin worthy of death would be homosexuality (**Leviticus 20:13** and **Romans 1:26-27, 32**) ; there was no sacrifice that could be given to receive forgiveness for that sin. A person found guilty of that sin would be put to death *without mercy*. The worship of other gods, graven images, breaking the Sabbaths, witchcraft, murder, eating blood, adultery, fornication, and blasphemy are few sins that are worthy of death. There are many more, studying the scriptures is very important. See, **Revelations 1:3**. **Hebrews 10:29** “*Of how much sorer punishment [How much worse is the punishment.] ,suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God [who had trampled or walked all over Christ], and hath counted the blood of the covenant [had considered the blood Christ shed for the new covenant/agreement], wherewith he was sanctified [which was used to cleanse his sins], an unholy thing [not sacred as something worthless and doesn't have to be respected], and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace [their sin was against the Holy Spirit and grace/mercy]?”* Do you think mercy is going to be shown to those that willfully commit sins worthy of death? NO! The punishment is going to be worse. Please read the following scriptures that reveal those that will not make it to the Kingdom of God. Read, **Galatians 5:19-21**, **1st Corinthians 6:9-11**, and **Ephesians 5:5-8**.
